<b>Introduction</b>	3 min	<p>Head of Studies + Head of Learning Support, Lene Pries-Heje</p> <p>Sharing knowledge about teaching at ITU and developing faculty's teaching capabilities is crucial to the quality of teaching and to ITU's institutional accreditation. Therefore, Learning Support has been given the responsibility to arrange workshops to develop faculty's teaching competences through professional didactic knowledge sharing.</p> <p>The first workshop will focus on the most significant challenges Learning Support observe at ITU at the moment. Exemplary cases from ITU will be shared and round out by trends observed in international research.</p>
<b>Current challenges</b>	8 min	<p>Presentation of and vote on importance of 3 current challenges in teaching:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Active participation in class</li> <li>• Providing enough and good feedback</li> <li>• Students have extremely different prerequisites for learning</li> </ul> <p>Depending on the preferences in the Department we will address 2-3 of the above challenges</p>
<b>Workshop</b>	2 x 8 min	<p>For each challenge the workshop format is</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Elaboration on vote from VIPs in the crowd: "how does this difficulty manifest for you?"</li> <li>• The broader perspective by LS: "what are usually the components of the challenge at stake?"</li> <li>• Solution: "this is an exemplary case from ITU"</li> <li>• Evidence of effect: "what are the trends from research, why this works and what other approaches work"</li> </ul>
